


DIVINE WORK IN THE SHADOW OF THE EGREGORE

As monks, friends and as contemplatives we are called in special and important ways; ways that may not be recognized or supported by the wider culture. So we need each other for support and the blessings of our collective wisdom. And most of all we need to know ourselves as the carriers of divine Energy and the loving light of Interbeing.

What are we being asked to do by Spirit? Are we listening to that guidance? How do we face inertia and resistance in order to truly step into the laborings to bring new birth into the world.? What needs to grow? What paths do we need to follow? What inner qualities must we foster for such birthing and grow? What support and help do we need?
