

The Gospel of Philip is a treasure trove of mystical wisdom. Lynn Bauman has been writing a commentary for the Gospel of Philip and has completed a first draft and it has been decided that it would be helpful to “beta test” his writing and the accompanying images during the editing of the text. This will be an opportunity to explore this dense, mysterious and sometimes inscrutable text. We have the opportunity to blend together Lynn’s understandings, the images we have created, in a collective circling inquiry in a practice we call midrash. We know from past experience that there is a kind of cross-pollination among a group of contemplatives that brings forth wisdom and understanding that would otherwise not arise.

You are invited to participate in this effort.

We will begin Zoom sessions of Midrash starting on Thursday, September 16th from 7-9pm Eastern Time and will meet on the first and third Thursday of the month. This exploration has no ending date and will probably continue over an number of years.

It is interesting that the Gospel of Philip is emerging in our time. It may seem strange to be exploring this esoteric text when the outer world is in collapse. And yet it has arrived. So for some of us this arrival may be an important way of meeting these times. Perhaps it is essential we tether ourselves firmly in the present and also root ourselves in the Wisdom of the Yeshua.

All are welcome, no prior experience of Midrash required.
